



**Camp One Step

Event Check-in/Registration: Entry is limited to the first **220** players who register.

Regular entry fee: \$275 for players and \$75 for spectators. Buffet and premium bar is included in the entry price.

High Roller Satellite entry fee: \$675. Players can significantly increase their chances of playing for a \$10,000 seat to the 2018 World Series of Poker. More information is available on our website www.camponestep.org.

Start Time: Tournament begins at 6:00pm. All players should be registered and seated by 5:45 pm.

TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

This tournament is a No-Limit, Single-Elimination, Texas Hold'em Poker Tournament with multiple re-buys. All floor director decisions are final. Poker Tournament Directors Association rules shall apply if there are any questions. Players shall be moved by tournament volunteers to different tables during any round to maintain a balanced number of players at each table and ensure fair and even play.

The Tournament will begin at 6:00 pm sharp and will last until there is one (1) winner. Every player will begin with a 5,000 chip count. There will be an opportunity at registration for a player to purchase **ONE 5,000 chip "instant" add-on** prior to the start of play for \$100. This option only is allowed before the start of play. At the onset, blinds will progress in the following increments every 15 minutes.

Re-buys and Add-on: There is also the opportunity for multiple re-buys until the end of the 20 minute BREAK following the 3000/6000 Blind Level. Players can make re-buys only at the BANK located adjacent to the poker room floor. A player can purchase as many re-buys as they like, but only when their chip count is below 2,500. Players may purchase a 5,000 chip re-buy for \$100 or a 10,000 chip-rebuy for \$200. The dealers shall provide the players with a re-buy ticket for the re-buys to present at the Bank. In addition, beginning with start of the tournament and ending after the 20 minute break following the 3000/6000 Blind Level, EVERY player in the room regardless of chip count, can make **ONE 10,000 chip add-on** for \$100. Each dealer will distribute to each player one add-on ticket at the beginning of the tournament.

Blind level 1 - Blinds will progress in the following increments every 15 minutes. Players will keep their chips with them for the entire tournament.

Last Chance Auction: Last opportunity to buy back into the tournament. All players that have been knocked out of the tournament can bid to purchase a 20,000 chip count. The auction will begin after the 4,000/8,000 blind level and the bidding will start at \$250. The auction winner(s) will be re-seated at a new table by tournament volunteers.

Blind level 7 - Blinds will progress in the following increments every 15 minutes.

THE FINAL ROUNDS. When the ten finalists have been determined they will be moved to the championship table where they will compete for the \$10,000 seat to the 2018 World Series of Poker and up to \$1,000 of verifiable travel expenses for airfare, hotel, meals and transportation to and from the airports. Blinds for this round will progress in the following increments every 20 minutes.

FINAL TABLE PRIZES

1st Place – 2018 WSOP Main Event Entry (\$10,000 value) and up to \$1,000 toward the winner’s verifiable travel expenses for airfare, hotel, meals and transportation to and from the airports while in Las Vegas for the 2018 WSOP Main Event.

All other players that reach the final table will receive a prize package to be revealed at the event.

NOTE: We reserve the right to alter the structure prior to the start of the event. We also reserve the right to alter the blinds as necessary to speed up tournament play.
