

# HIGH ROLLER SATELLITE TOURNAMENT "OPTION"

# What is the High Roller Satellite?

For a \$675 entry fee players can significantly increase their chances of playing for a \$10,000 seat to the 2018 World Series of Poker. Players in the High Roller Satellite tournament have about a 1 in 10 chance of making it directly to the final table (with a strong chip stack equivalent 4<sup>th</sup> place regular tournament player at the final table).

The Tournament Structure shall be substantially the same as the regular tournament except that there will be no re-buys or add-ons. You will be moved to another table prior to the completion of the High Roller Satellite.

### How many seats are available?

We will begin with  $\underline{two}$  High Roller tables with a minimum of 8 players and a maximum of 10 players per table. We will take the first 8 to 10 players for the first table and the next 8 to 10 players at the second table until we fill the tables. If there are less than 8 players signed up for one of the High Roller tables, that High Roller table will be broken down and all of those players will be reseated at another table in the regular tournament and the difference in the entry fee shall be refunded.

# How do I register for a seat?

Players can register for a seat in the High Roller tournament by clicking on the "Register" button on the website and completing the High Roller registration. The first players to sign up will have priority. Any available seats on the day of the event can be purchased at registration on a first come-first serve basis. Once we reach 20 registered players we will close registration. Only one seat can be reserved per person or email address.

# What is the total Cost?

\$675.

# When do I pay for the High Roller Satellite Fee?

If you have registered for the High Roller tournament someone at registration will confirm that you signed up. If you have not signed up prior to the event and want to be in the High Roller tournament you will not pay the High Roller entry fee until we determine if there is availability for you to play. If we have determined there is availability for you to play at the High Roller table, we will request that you go to the BANK to pay the High Roller Fee or the additional fee if you previously signed up for the regular tournament. You will then be directed to your High Roller table.

#### When does it start?

The High Roller Satellite will start at the same time as the regular tournament or shortly thereafter.

# What is my chip stack to start?

10,000. The same amount as the regular tournament.

# When does High Roller Satellite end?

The High Roller Satellite will end when there are only <u>2 players remaining</u> in the High Roller Tournament. The 2 winners must provide their names and information to the dealer so they can be registered to play in the final table play whenever the regular tournament gets down to 8 or 9 players.

# What will the winner(s) chip stack be the final table?

The High Roller table winner(s) will start with a new chip stack equivalent to the regular tournament player with the 4th highest chip stack at the final table.

# Can I get back in the "regular" tournament if I am eliminated?

Any High Roller player that is eliminated from the High Roller table prior to the start of blind level (4,000/8,000) in the regular tournament (which follows the **first break** in play) can rebuy and add-on like everyone else in the regular tournament.

In addition, all players that have been knocked out of the regular and High Roller tournament before the end of blind level (4,000/8,000) will also have an opportunity to bid to purchase a 20,000 chip count to get back into the regular tournament. The auction will begin after the 4,000/8,000 blind level and the bidding will start at \$250. The auction winner(s) will be reseated by table by tournament volunteers.
