

APPLE BIRD FEEDER

Instructions:

1: Gather all your supplies.

2: Place your apple onto the plate, and carefully use the butter knife to cut the apple in half.

3: Grab your 2 paper clips and pull them back on the open ends so they look like hooks! Then push the end of the hook into the top of the apple where the stem is.

4: Take the spoon and carefully scoop out just a little bit of the middle of each half of the apple where the core/seeds are.

5: Next, take the butter knife and spread some peanut/nut butter on each half of the apple.

6: Take your other plate and put about 2-3 handfuls of the birdseed on it. Then dip your apple halves into the birdseed until all of the peanut/nut butter is covered with the seeds!

7: Next, cut 2 pieces of string about the length of your arm. Once your string is cut, tie one end around the curved end of the paperclip sticking out of the apple half. Do this for both halves of your apples.

8: Hang up your apple bird feeders outside!

Supplies Needed

- 1 medium/large apple
- Peanut butter/ nut butter alternative
- Butter knife (adult supervision) Spoon
- Birdseed or Sunflower seeds
- 2 Paper Clips
- String
- Scissors
- 2 Plates
- A tree or area outside to hang your bird feeder
