

SOCK GNOMES

Instructions:

1. Cover and protect your workspace with a plastic tablecloth.
2. Cut the solid colored sock straight across, just below the heel. Pull the sock over the cone, starting at the flat bottom. Use hot glue to secure it in place.
3. Cut a strip of faux fur for the beard (about as wide as the front side of the cone) and glue on top of the sock. It should be about halfway up the cone.
4. Glue a wooden bead on top of the beard. It should attach near the top of the beard, but not touching the sock.
5. Turn the patterned sock inside out and cut a diagonal line, roughly from the back of the heel to the top of the toe. Lift up the top edge, glue along the line you just cut, and carefully press back together to seal.
6. When the glue has cooled, flip the sock right side out, and pull it over the top of the cone. The fabric may stick to the styrofoam as you're pulling - it's easiest to scrunch the sock with your thumbs inside and pull the hat down.
7. Move the hat up or down to wherever you prefer. You can cuff the bottom and add any extra decorations.

Supplies Needed:

- 1 Patterned Sock
- 1 Solid Sock
- 1 Foam Cone (no taller than the socks)
- 1 Faux Fur Beard Piece
- 1 Wood Bead
- Hot Glue Sticks or Quick-Dry Craft Glue

Tools & Equipment:

- Hot Glue Gun
